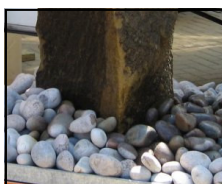
The versatility of natural stone lends itself to a wide range of concepts and design capabilities, and brings an assurance of quality to classic and contemporary designs alike.

The excellent slip resistant properties of Crosland Hill Hard York Stone and sympathetic appearance make an ideal surrounding to ponds and streams and is ideally suited for stepping stones and pathways.

The timeless appeal of a monolith feature can be used to make a bold statement as a central feature, or a subtle background to add form to a focal point. These features are available in a variety of sizes from over 3 metres in height down to small hand manageable sizes.



The use of monoliths as the focal point of a water feature had been made easier by the range and availability of inexpensive water pumps. Pebbles, coloured gravels and small stones can be incorporated into the designer's material range to give a flexibility of design to suit the most creative mind.
